The Parade will begin at Sagemont Church Parking Lot K off of Hughes Road at 10 a.m. The route takes Hughes to Blackhawk, Blackhawk to Scarsdale, Scarsdale to Beamer and Beamer to San Jacinto College South Campus. Lineup starts at 9:00 a.m. Judging for trophies will be at 9:30 a.m. Individuals, groups and businesses are encouraged to build floats, decoarte vehicles and participate.

Each entry will receive a parade permit at lineup to be displayed on the windshield.

Adult supervision is mandatory! **Due to the length, NO WALKING ALLOWED IN THE PARADE.** For everyone's safety, **NO alcohol or glass containers, water ballons or water guns.** This is a celebration of the 250th Birthday of America! **Only United States of America, Texas and U.S. military flags are allowed.** Candy, small trinkets, beads, etc. to toss from your float or vehicle to spectators is encouraged.
